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Identifiable Personal Information

WSSEF complies with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Policy of 2000. 2. For students in grades 1 – 6, all judging requiring the student to be at their projects will be completed Friday night. All projects must remain in place until 5:00 PM Saturday for further special judging.
3. For students in grades 7 –12, all judging will occur Saturday.
4. Project removal starts at 5:00 PM on Saturday and must be completed by 5:30 PM, before the start of the Awards Ceremony. Awards Ceremony starts at 6:00 PM

Complete all forms and return to WSSEF by the March 13, 2010 deadline.
